Genesis 1:24-31

- 24 Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind; cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, *each* according to its kind"; and it was so.
- 25 And God made the beast of the earth according to its kind, cattle according to its kind, and everything that creeps on the earth according to its kind. And God saw that *it was* good.
- 26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all [the] earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

27 So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."


29 And God said, "See, I have given you every herb *that* yields seed which *is* on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food.

Scientists recover T. Rex soft tissue

March 24, 2005 - For more than a century, the study of dinosaurs has been limited to fossilized bones. Now, researchers have recovered '70 million-year-old' soft tissue, including what may be blood vessels and cells, from a Tyrannosaurus Rex.



'The lab filled with murmurs of amazement, for I had focused on something inside the vessels that none of us had ever noticed before: tiny round objects, translucent red with a dark center. Then a colleague took one look at them and shouted, "You've got red blood cells. You've got red blood cells!"'

Schweitzer confronted her boss, famous paleontologist 'Dinosaur' Jack Horner, with her doubts about how these could really be blood cells. Horner suggested she try to prove they were not red blood cells, and she says, 'So far, we haven't been able to.'

3 Categories Of Land Animals

1. **Cattle:** Domesticated Animals (Cattle, Horses, Goats)
2. **Creeping Thing:** Anything that scurries, crawls or is low to the ground. (snakes, frogs, moles)
3. **Beast of the Earth:** Untamed animals (Lions, Rhinos, wildebeests, bears)

Genesis 1:24

24 Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to **its kind**: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, *each* according to **its kind**"; and it was so.

This Phrase used 10 Times In Genesis 1

Genesis 1:24-25

24 Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: 1)cattle and 2)creeping thing and 3)beast of the earth, *each* according to its kind"; and it was so.

25 And God made the 1)beast of the earth according to its kind, 2)cattle according to its kind, and everything that 3)creeps on the earth according to its kind. And God saw that *it was good*.

Man's Best Thinking

Genesis 1:30
