Genesis 4:16

16 Then Cain went out from the presence of the LORD and dwelt in the **land of Nod** on the east of Eden.

Nowd (Land of Nod)
Nod = ""wandering"

Genesis 4:17

17 And Cain knew his wife, and she conceived and bore Enoch...

- Enoch = dedicate, Initiate, Begin
- Not The Enoch That Gets Raptured (Gen. 5:24, Heb. 11:5) And Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

Genesis 4:17

17 ... And he built a city, and called the name of the city after the name of his son—Enoch.

- A City is Usually Named After The One Who Takes Ownership and Responsibility for it.
- **2 Samuel 5:7** Nevertheless David took the stronghold of Zion (that is, the City of David).
- **2 Samuel 12:27-28** And Joab sent messengers to David, and said, "I have fought against Rabbah, and I have taken the city's water *supply*. 28 Now therefore, gather the rest of the people together and encamp against the city and take it, lest I take the city and it be called after my name."

Genesis 4:18:19

18. To Enoch was born Irad; and Irad begot Mehujael, and Mehujael begot Methushael, and Methushael begot Lamech.

- The First Polygamist

21 His brother's name was Jubal. He was the father of all those who play the harp and flute.



Harp or Lyre

proclaim THE NAME OF THE LORD!
