Genesis 6:9-12

9 This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God.

10 And Noah begot three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

11 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

Genesis 6:9

9 Noah was a **just** man, **perfect** in his **generations**...

- *tsaddiyq* (Just) just, lawful, righteous

Hebrews 11:7

By **faith** Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to **faith**.

Genesis 6:9

9 Noah was a **just** man, **perfect** in his **generations**...

Possible Meaning One

- Just & Perfect: These words together mean "genuine righteousness"

In contrast to the others of Noah's time

Possible Meaning Two

perfect in his **generations**...

- *tamiym* (perfect) complete, whole, sound without blemish 44, perfect 18, upright 8,...
- *dowr* (generations) period, generation

Genetically Capable of Repopulating the Earth.

Genesis 6:9

9 Noah walked with God.

Used in Gen 5:22, 24 of Enoch

- Indicated a Continual Pattern of Life
- A Marked Contrast to Those of His Day

Noah's Character

- **Hebrews 11:7** By faith Noah, being divinely warned of things not yet seen, **moved with godly fear**, prepared an ark for the saving of his household, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith.
- **2 Peter 2:5** and did not spare the ancient world, but saved Noah, one of eight people, **a preacher of righteousness**, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly;

10 And Noah begot three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

11 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

shachath (corrupt)
to destroy, corrupt, go to ruin, decay

Sinful Violent People Had Ruined the Earth

Genesis 6:12

So God looked upon the earth, and indeed it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth.

Psalm 14:2-3

2 The LORD looks down from heaven upon the children of men, To see if there are any who understand, who seek God.

3 They have all turned aside, They have together become corrupt; *There is* none who does good, No, not one.

Psalm 23

Isaiah 40

- 27** Why do you say, O Jacob, And speak, O Israel: " My way is hidden from the LORD, And my just claim is passed over by my God"?"
- 28** Have you not known? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, The Creator of the ends of the earth, Neither faints nor is weary. His understanding is unsearchable.
- 29** He gives power to the weak, And to *those who have no might* He increases strength.
- 30** Even the youths shall faint and be weary, And the young men shall utterly fall,
- 31** But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew *their* strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

Romans 8:1

[*Free from Indwelling Sin*]

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not **walk** according to the flesh, but according to the **Spirit**.

Galatians 5:16

[*Walking in the Spirit*]

I say then: **Walk** in the **Spirit**, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Ezekiel 36:27

I will put My **Spirit** within you and cause you to **walk** in My statutes, and you will keep My judgments and do them.

1 John 2

- 3** Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments.
- 4** He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.
- 5** But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.
- 6** He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.
