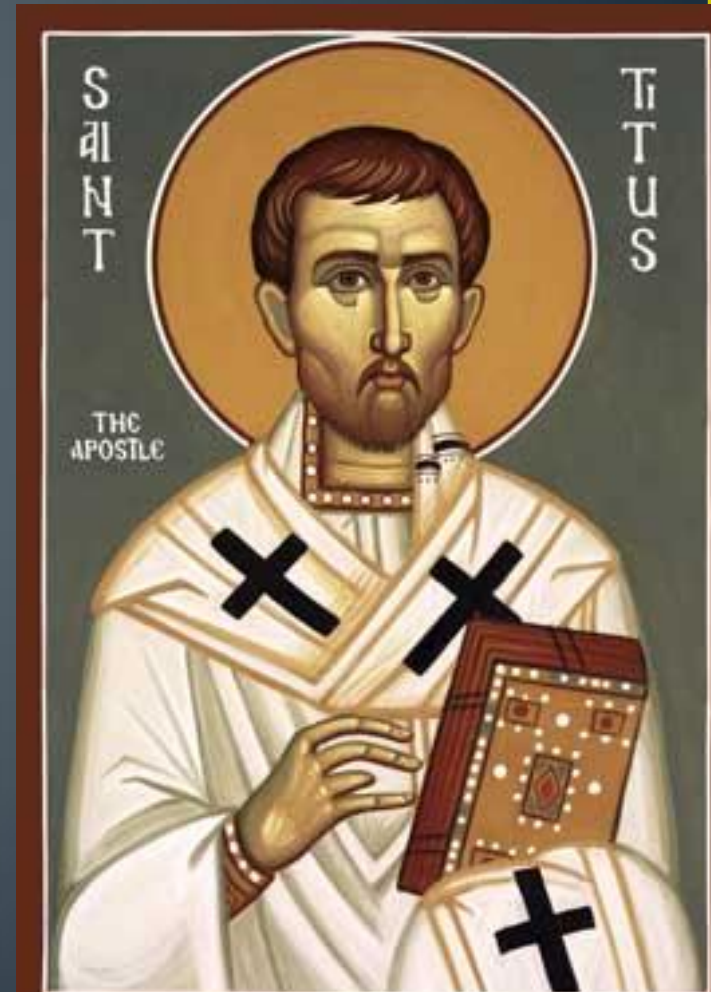
# About the Titus

Greek Τίτος (*Titos*), occurs 13 times  
in 12 verses



# Who Are You Looking After?

(2 Corinthians 2:13)

I had no rest in my spirit, because I did not find **Titus** my brother; but taking my leave of them, I departed for Macedonia.

# Who Brings You Comfort?

(2 Corinthians 7:6-7)

*Nevertheless God, who comforts the downcast, comforted us by the coming of Titus, 7 and not only by his coming, but also by the consolation with which he was comforted in you, when he told us of your earnest desire, your mourning, your zeal for me, so that I rejoiced even more.*

# Who Do You Rejoice With?

(2 Corinthians 7:13)

*Therefore we have been comforted in your comfort. And we rejoiced exceedingly more for the joy of **Titus**, because his spirit has been refreshed by you all.*



# Who Do You Talk Ministry With?

(2 Corinthians 7:14)

*For if in anything I have boasted to him about you, I am not ashamed. But as we spoke all things to you in truth, even so our boasting to **Titus** was found true.*

# Who Do You Exhort?

(2 Corinthians 8:5-6)

*And not only as we had hoped, but they first gave themselves to the Lord, and then to us by the will of God. <sup>6</sup> So we urged Titus, that as he had begun, so he would also complete this grace in you as well.*

# Who Do You Exhort? (2 Corinthians 8:5-6)

- ex·hort
- *verb*
- **1.** strongly encourage or urge (someone) to do something.

Who is of like mind and heart?  
(2 Corinthians 8:16-17)

**2 Cor 8:16-17** But thanks be to God who puts the same earnest care for you into the heart of **Titus**. <sup>17</sup> For he not only accepted the exhortation, but being more diligent, he went to you of his own accord.

# Who is Your partner and co-worker? (2 Corinthians 8:23)

*If anyone inquires about **Titus**, he is my partner and fellow worker concerning you. Or if our brethren are inquired about, they are messengers of the churches, the glory of Christ.*

# Who Do You Send?

(2 Corinthians 12:18)

*I urged Titus, and sent our brother with him. Did Titus take advantage of you? Did we not walk in the same spirit? Did we not walk in the same steps?*

## Who is Baring Fruit? (Galatians 2:1-3)

*Then after fourteen years I went up again to Jerusalem with Barnabas, and also took **Titus** with me. 2 And I went up by revelation, and communicated to them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to those who were of reputation, lest by any means I might run, or had run, in vain. 3 Yet not even **Titus** who was with me, being a Greek, was compelled to be circumcised.*

# Who is the Source? (God)

- **Grace** (*the free unmerited love and favor of God*)
- **Mercy** (*to treat an offender better than he deserves*)
- **Peace** (*Freedom from agitation or disturbance*)
