# Sound Doctrine

## Sound:

**a** : free from injury or disease

**b** : free from flaw, defect, or decay

**2**: SOLID, FIRM; *also* : STABLE

**3** free from error, fallacy, or misapprehension

## Doctrine:

a set of ideas or beliefs that are taught or believed to be true (Biblical Teachings)

# Jesus saves and is the only way

## Romans Road

- **All have sinned.** Rm 3:10-12, and 23 *“No one is righteous—not even one.*
- **The price (or consequence) of sin is death.**  
Rm 6:23 *For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.*
- **Jesus Christ died for our sins. He paid the price for our death.** Rm 5:8 *But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.*

# Jesus saves and is the only way

## Romans Road

**We receive eternal life through faith in Jesus**

**Christ.** Rm 10:9-10, and 13 *If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved ... For “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”*

# Jesus saves and is the only way

## Romans Road

### Salvation brings us into a relationship of peace

**with God.** *Rm 5:1 Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us.*

**Romans 8:1** *So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus.*

**Rm 8:38-39** *And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

# Jesus saves and is the only way

- **John 14:6** *Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.*
- **Acts 4:12** *Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”*

# We are Christ's and not our own

- **Galatians 2:20** *I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.*
- **1 Corinthians 6:19-20** Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit *who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own?* <sup>20</sup> For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

## *Biblical world view*

- **Worldview** : The overall perspective from which one sees and interprets the world. 2. A collection of beliefs about life and the universe held by an individual or a group.
- **Biblical Worldview**: Have the mind of Christ. Think like Christ; love like Christ; act like Christ; walk like Christ: have the humility, patience, longsuffering and all of the other [Galatians 5:22–26](#) fruits of the Spirit.

## *Biblical world view (For God's Glory)*

- **John 17:1** [ *Jesus Prays for Himself* ] Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: “**Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You,**
- **Romans 15:5-6** Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> that you may with one mind *and* one mouth **glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.**

# *Biblical world view (Relationships)*

## **1 Corinthians 13:4-8**

Love suffers long *and* is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up;<sup>5</sup> does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; <sup>6</sup> does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; <sup>7</sup> bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

- <sup>8</sup> Love never fails.

## *Biblical world view (Employment)*

- **Colossians 3:22-23** *Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eye service, as men-pleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God. <sup>23</sup> And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, <sup>24</sup> knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.*

## *Biblical world view (Finance)*

- **Matthew 6:33** But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
- **Proverbs 22:7** The rich rules over the poor, And the borrower *is* servant to the lender.
- **2 Corinthians 9:7-8** So *let* each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. <sup>8</sup> And God *is* able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all *things*, may have an abundance for every good work.

## *Biblical world view (Health)*

- **1 Timothy 4:8** For bodily exercise profits a little, but godliness is profitable for all things, having promise of the life that now is and of that which is to come.
- **1 Corinthians 3:16-17** *Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? <sup>17</sup> If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy him. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple.*
