- 2 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3 I thank my God upon every remembrance of you,

- 4 always in every prayer of mine making request for you all with joy,
- 5 for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now,
- 6 being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;
- 7 just as it is right for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart, inasmuch as both in my chains and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel, you all are partakers with me of grace.

Bishops & Deacons (Leadership)

- Bishops, Elders, Pastors
 (Used Interchangeably in Acts 20:17 & Titus 1:5,7 & 1
 Peter 5:1-3)
 - Those Who Watch Over The Spiritual Welfare Of The Local Church
 - Must Be Apt To Teach
- Deacons: Refers to those who served the congregation in special service capacities. They were charged with handling the physical and material concerns of the church. (Not Teachers)

Epiteleō (Finish)

1) to bring to an end, accomplish, perfect, execute, complete

John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, It is finished(teleō) and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Jude 1:24

Glory to God

The Opposite

Worry: to afflict with mental distress or agitation: make anxious

Fear: expect with alarm <fear the worst>
